

RFP - NEORide Collision Avoidance
Response to Vendor Questions on 7/5/22

1. Please provide the list of buses/vehicles at BCRTA so they can be quoted properly.

BCRTA is requesting one Gillig bus to be furnished with a collision avoidance system with the option of up to 8 more commuter coaches in the future.

2. In regards to Page 12 Section Interface with Onboard CAD/AVL, please list the CAD/AVL systems that the Collision Avoidance System would be integrating with.

BCRTA is currently utilizing GMV Syncromatics as the Operations Platform and Optibus is the Planning and Scheduling Software.

SARTA is utilizing Avail.

SORTA is utilizing Trapeze

3. On page 12 Section Interface with Onboard Camera Systems, what brand(s) of camera systems would we be integrating with?

BCRTA is using Seon (TX8). There is no integration now, but it is set to be done soon.

SARTA uses Seon. There is no integration with CAD/AVL.

SORTA is using Apollo with no integration with CAD/AVL.

4. Are your current camera systems integrated with the CAD/AVL system?

5. On page 12 Section 2.5 Design Review, will NEORide be providing oversight and management of the design reviews or will that be managed by each transit individually?

NEORide will be overseeing project management in coordination with agencies.

6. Will the bi-weekly meetings be managed by NEORide or directly with each transit?

NEORide with attendance by all agencies.

- 7. Please define “Final System Acceptance”. Will it apply to completion of individual buses or the last bus of a given fleet?**

NEORide is happy to make payments after the completion of each transits fleet individually, as timelines may not coordinate exactly.

- 8. There is conflicting information in the RFP, please confirm that the standard warranty period is 1 year.**

We are asking for a standard warranty of one-year with the pricing of up to 3 years.

- 9. What are the operating hours and days of the week for each of the transits?**

BCRTA operates Monday – Friday 4 a.m. to 11:55 p.m. EST

SARTA operates Monday – Saturday 5:30 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. EST

SORTA operates Monday-Sunday 24 hours a day

- 10. What is the expected award date and installation start date?**

No final date has been set.

- 11. On Addendum A, SORTA bus section is asking for a quote of 356 buses but the vehicles list only shows 309, are there other buses? If so, can you provide the updated vehicle list?**

309 is the correct fleet list. No agency support vehicles will be included.

- 12. On Addendum A, SARTA bus section is asking for a quote of 115 buses but the vehicle list shows 141 vehicles. Which number is correct? If the former, which buses are excluded from planned installations?**

SARTA has confirmed a total of 120 vehicles. No agency support vehicles will be included.

Specific vehicles not included are Dodge Caravan, Dodge Durango, Dodge Ram, CHVY C70, Optima VS24 Trolley, Chevy Duramax
